This letter will confirm our telephone conversation earlier today wherein I advised you that in the case referenced above it would be most useful for an amicus brief to be filed with the Court which would counter the APA Brief. The APA Brief (now known as the "Barker Brief" due to the withdrawal of the APA as an amicus) essentially asserts that the proposition of "brainwashing" is a myth and by extension, Margaret Singer is slightly short of a bigoted crackpot to assert otherwise.

So long as no responsible mental health professionals do not say otherwise, the inference may be more easily drawn that the position of Barker et al is correct.

Time is of the essence. The last brief in the case was filed on March 18, 1987. Now, the case awaits setting of oral argument.
