

Dear Mr. De'Medici:

I write as a former director of CAN National, as a former director and national coordinator of FOCUS, the ex-member support group, and as an individual member of CAN. I am extremely concerned about the mailing lists and files of members remaining confidential. When I joined CAN I did so with the understanding that my name and address and other information would be kept in confidence unless I choose to make it public.

Of even greater concern to me, however, is the records and files of any former cult member who has filled out a FOCUS questionnaire. As part of those questionnaires, we also encouraged people to submit their "stories" and personal accounts to us. I served as National Coordinator of FOCUS for four years and served on its board of directors until it dissolved and we became a committee of CAN. After that committee was reorganized by the CAN board, the majority of the prior board of FOCUS voted to re-establish ourselves independently of CAN and incorporated and currently operate under the name of reFOCUS. I can provide documentation for this, if necessary. At any rate, security and confidentiality are crucial to former members of cults and cultic organizations. It is important that ex-members are free from harassment. For that reason, we had a confidentiality agreement as part of the FOCUS questionnaire (2nd page). It is crucial that these records remain confidential. I urge you to place the records of FOCUS, and FOCUS questionnaires, names addresses, files and testimonials or personal accounts in the hands of either Marty Bulz, who served on the FOCUS board as vice-president for years and was a full time employee of CAN, or in the hands of the reFOCUS board where we can be assured that former members are protected.




Alternatively, you may send us your assurances in writing that all such records and files, originals and all copies, have been secured from sale or release, or destroyed.

My contact with CAN as a member and someone who provided information to the organization was predicated on the understanding that my name and any information I provided CAN would be strictly confidential. I ask that as the trustee in this matter you continue to honor the confidential relationship I enjoyed with CAN in the past.

It is hard to put into words how concerned I am that information maintained by CAN will be purchased by the very organizations CAN informed the public about. Once the information and records are obtained by these groups I believe it will be used to harass those who had associated with CAN in the past.

I anticipate however you will remove any information identifiable with me from assets to be sold and notify me of the steps you have taken to protect my privacy. I look forward to hearing from you in the near future.
